

Finish Corral in Cross Country

Rule 8

- With a finish corral, the finish line is opened to its full width when using transponders for order of finish allowing competitors to race through the line.
- The use of a chute may restrict running space therefore, the corral should be used with transponder place finish as it allows runners to race through the finish line, perform administrative tasks as directed by meet management and then progress in an orderly fashion out of the corral.
